## USBWA COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The United States Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) will award a \$1,000 annual scholarship to the son or daughter of a USBWA member entering college as a freshman for the 2013 fall semester or is currently enrolled in a junior college or four-year institution and plans to return to school in the fall.

The student will receive \$1,000 each year he or she remains in school (maximum of four years), takes a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester and maintains a minimum GPA of 3.0. Only one \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded each year other than to those students who have their scholarships renewed.

Applicants must demonstrate academic excellence and show achievement in citizenship and leadership in a community activity.

Criteria:

- 1. Applicants must achieve a cumulative GPA of at least 3.00 in high school or college
- 2. Applicants must enroll in a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester in college
- 3. Recipients must reapply to the USBWA no later than June 1 to receive the \$1,000 scholarship each year the student is enrolled in school. Renewal of the scholarship each year is contingent on the student maintaining a 3.0 GPA in college and enrolling in 12 credit hours per semester.
- 4. Applicants may submit a maximum of three recommendations with their application
